self learning workbook for ages 3-7 for children who know their alphabet phonics is the bedrock of learning to read we use phonics and writing to enhance critical thinking skills

this is the second of a set of three workbooks and contains units 2 and 3 of 5 units the reading workbooks have two pages for each lesson the exercises are closely associated with the corresponding lessons in the readers these exercises include practice with the vocabulary words practice in writing sentences drills for developing comprehension skills and seatwork in various forms

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
